#### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1997

#### 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The West Carrol Soil and Water Conservation Devict was availed by the Losisiana Legislature. The Devict primetry issuits fermion and other land users in the work use of their lands and the prevention of availand of fam and urban land and the politiking of waters in the state. The financial statement of the West Cannol Soil and Water Conservation District are prepared in accordance with the standards established by the GASB. #### A. FUND ACCOUNTING

The financial statements of the West Carrol Soli and Water Conservation District.

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are presented as if the accounts were expanible on the basis of funds and account groups, each of which would be considered a separate accounting entity. Since the Derivic has no financial resources which are required to be accounted for in other funds, only a common coestion's band was used.

#### B. FIXED ASSETS

Field assets used in the governmental fund type operations are accounted for in the General Fixed Assets account group, rather than the Governmental Fund. No depreciation has been provided on general fixed assets. All fixed assets are valued at hitstocial cost.

This account group is not a "fund." It is concerned with the measurement of financial position, not with measurement of operations.

#### c. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

#### (f) Revenue

State Funds are recorded when the District is entitled to the funds.

Newsletter sponsors and equipment rental are recorded in the year earned.

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Rents and rovallies are recorded in the war earned.

Subsequently all other revenues are recorded when received.

(2) Expenditures

Expenditures were recognized in the accounting period in which the labilities are both measurable and incurred.

#### D. BUDGETARY PRACTICES

A budget was submitted to the Office of Soil and Water Conservation, Louisana Department of Apriculture and Forestry. State Funding for the year was based upon the allocation procedures established in the program rules and regulations.

#### E. ANNUAL AND SICK LEAVE

Employees earn and accumulate annual and sick teave at various rates depending on their yeast of service. Unused annual and sick leave documulates whether limit. The number of houses of unused annual leave for which an employee may receive a lump sum payment upon termination from Datistic employment may not exceed 300 hours.

At June 30, 1997 (fread close), the West Carrol Sol and Water Conservation District had accumulated and vested \$790.00 in serve privileges, required to be accurated under SFAS 43. Current year expenditures for salary and leave privileges total \$27,553,55.

#### F. PENSION PLAN SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

Substantially all employees of the West Carroll Sol and Water Conservation District

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are members of the Social Security System. The Employee contribution was 7.65% of gross salary from July 1, 1996, through June 30, 1997. The District contributed on additional 7.65% of gross salary from July 1, 1996, through June 30, 1997. The District does not guarantee the benefits greated by the Social Security System.
