NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS As of and for the Year Ended December 31, 2012

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Indian Village Water System, Inc. is a nonprofit organization domiciled in Calhoun, Louisiana, and organized under the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statutes 12 201-269. The water system is governed by a five member board of directors who are members of the water system and who are elected by members of the water system. The water system serves approximately 595 members.

A. FINANCIAL STATEMENT PRESENTATION

FASB Accounting Standards Codification (FASB ASC) 958, Not-For-Profit Entities - Presentation of Financial Statements, formerly known as Statement of Financial Accounting Standards (SFAS) No 117, Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations requires Indian Village Water System, Inc., to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets, unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets. In addition, Indian Village Water System, Inc., is required to present a statement of cash flows. Indian Village Water System, Inc., had only unrestricted net assets during the year ended December 31, 2012.

B. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

Basis of accounting refers to when revenues and expenses are recognized in the accounts and reported in the financial statements. Basis of accounting relates to the timing of the measurements made, regardless of the measurement focus applied. The accompanying financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting Revenues are recognized when they are earned, and expenses are recognized when they are incurred.

C. ESTIMATES

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates

D. FIXED ASSETS

Major improvements to the water system and equipment costing \$1,000 or more that are expected to have a useful life of at least five years are capitalized by the water system Fixed assets are recorded at actual cost Depreciation of all exhaustible fixed assets is charged as an expense against operations Depreciation is computed using the straight-line method over estimated useful lives of 25 to 50 years for the water production and distribution systems and 5 to 10 years for equipment Depreciation expense for the year was \$39,081

E. DEPOSITS IN FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

At December 31, 2012, the water system had cash in checking accounts totaling \$83,818 Cash (bank balances) at December 31, 2012 were fully secured by FDIC insurance
