The objective of a compilation is to assist the management of the West Carroll Soil and Water Conservation District, in presenting financial information in the form of financial statements without undertaking to obtain or provide any assurance that there are no material modifications that should be made to the financial statements.

Accordingly, these financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.

The effects of this departure from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America have not been determined.
